

Currently a Veterans Badge **can** be issued to:

- Men and women who served in HM Armed Forces up to and including **31 December 1994**. The following groups who **served during World War II** are also eligible;
  - Polish Forces under UK Command, Cyprus Regiment and Home Guard.

Posthumous Applications:

The Veterans Badge can only be issued posthumously to either War Widows or Widowers receiving a War Widows or Widowers pension from Service Personnel and Veterans Agency. The deceased must have served before **31 December 1994**.
